Literacy

Physical Development

- Fine Motor Skills
- hold pencil, crayon, markers in pincer grasp (HWWT)
- trace straight and curved lines
- trace or write first name
- hold scissors with correct grasp
- string beads, sew shapes
- roll dough into a log
- try to snap, button, zip clothes

Cognitive

- engage with peers and teachers
- show pride in learning
- show desire to solve problems

Mathematic

- identify numbers 1-8
- count past 10
- count 10 items in a group (1 to 1 correspondence)
- identify simple shapes
- know simple a/b pattern
- calendar readiness

Gross Motor

- move easily inside and outside (balance)
- use bathroom and wash hands without help
- eat and drink without help
- put on coat
- pack backpack
- try to skip, stand on one foot, hop on one foot

Spiritual

- love God and knows that God loves her/him
- know that God listens to our prayers
