REGISTRATION INFO FOR FALL 2021-2022

Planning for our September 2021 school year has begun! Currently enrolled students are guaranteed a spot in our program, siblings are then placed next, church members, alumni, & wait list families followed by the public. Stay tuned for costs and fees which will be decided upon at our upcoming PAT meeting on January 21.

Procedures & Dates for 2021-2022 Registration*:

- In House Registration begins on Tuesday, January 26, 2021.
- The registration form will be emailed to you and also available on our website Saturday, January 24 for you to print and complete.
- We will start collecting the forms and fees in person on Tuesday, January 26 at our drive by drop-off time from 10-11 am. The next opportunity to drive by/drop-off will be Wednesday, January 27 from 3-4 pm.
- After January 27, the back door will be unlocked between 10 am to 4 pm on both January 28 & 29 for your convenience to drop off form and registration fee. Please wear a mask upon entering our building.

After February 2, we will not be able to guarantee you a spot in our program as our registration opens to Alumni/Church/Waitlist families register. Public registration begins on February 9.

*Remember if you want certain days, you need to turn your registration form in early with your registration payment. Checks made payable to ITBP. We cannot accept cash at this time. ♥

Happy New Year and wishing you a deeper relationship with God and for His world.

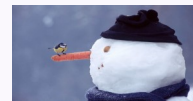
